## ***Preventing the Top 5 Insider Attacks***

**Guest speaker:** Peter Wood  
*First Base Technologies*

Over the past ten years, Peter Wood and his team at First Base Technologies have conducted numerous network penetration tests and audits for some of the largest organisations in the UK.

Over this extended period he has found clear evidence that most networks share the same five common vulnerabilities, all of which could be negated by good planning and a reasonable level of security awareness.

In this presentation he discusses each of these vulnerabilities, illustrated by real-world examples, and suggests ways in which your exposure to attack can be minimised.

### **Peter Wood**

Peter is Chief of Operations at First Base Technologies, an ethical hacking firm based in the UK. Peter founded First Base in 1989 and has hands-on technical involvement in the firm on a daily basis, working in areas as diverse as network security reviews, firewall penetration testing and policy and procedures.

Peter is a popular speaker at many international conferences and was recently rated the British Computer Society's number one speaker. Peter's innovative and entertaining style has led him to present to the boards of the largest international companies as well as at international conferences on many IT security-related topics.

Peter has worked in the electronics and computer industries since 1969. He has extensive experience of international communications and networking, with hands-on experience of many large-scale systems. Peter's board-level responsibilities have included sales, marketing and technical roles, giving him a broad industry view.

Peter is a Fellow of the British Computer Society and member of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers, ISACA and the Association of Computing Machinery. He is also a BCS Registered Security Consultant, a Microsoft Certified Product Specialist and a member of Mensa.
