Guest speaker: Charlie O'Rourke

Charlie is a Director of Solcara, a software company he and three of his colleagues established over 6 years following a management buyout of an American NASDAQ listed company. He currently heads the Reputation Management Division of Solcara and has worked with the communications teams of organisations from a wide variety of sectors; from the Metropolitan Police to The London Mayor, Severn Trent to Thomas Cook; helping them maintain consistency in their dealings with the media both during major incidents and throughout their day to day activities. He has been instrumental in the design, marketing and implementation of PressBureau, Solcara's software for media relations teams. He is also responsible for the development of Solcara Crisis Control Centre; web-based incident management software.

In his presentation, Charlie will proactively demonstrate how business continuity teams are more effectively collaborating during major incidents and operational crises. He will draw on his experience of working with large city institutions to show how team members can work together in a virtual environment to help restore business normality in times of crisis.

He will examine how easy to use information management tools, that enable the capture and distribute of information among senior executives, can help to deliver the right information to the right people, in order to protect corporate reputation.
