Latest developments in COBIT 4.1

Guest speaker: Roger Southgate CISA CISM MBS FCCA
ISACA London Chapter

Roger's presentation will show the latest developments in COBIT, highlighting the difference between COBIT 4 and 4.1 and introducing the new Control Practices and Assurance Guide - showing how these fit together and compliment each other.

Roger is the current Vice President of the London Chapter of ISACA, with responsibilities for IT Governance and Standards. He has been active in both the promotion and ongoing development of COBIT since 2002. He co-ordinates the London COBIT development group and was seconded to the core COBIT development team for the version 4 re-write.

Roger is also active with ISACA internationally. He has delivered COBIT /IT Governance training on behalf of ISACA in Europe, Africa, and Australia. He has been a member of the programme committee for the ISACA European Eurocacs Conferences in 2006 and 2007 and has been invited to join the committee for next year.

A qualified accountant with over 20 years experience in delivering IT services and value, whilst maintaining a secure environment equip him with a pragmatic approach, experience and insight.

Roger discovered COBIT during his 18 year career with a Japanese Investment Bank in London, where for over 15 years he was CIO.

He is now an independent consultant and recent consulting assignments have included IT policy development, process maturity assessments, IT Governance training/mentoring, Sarbanes Oxley preparation quality reviews and a security discovery workshop.

He is a regular speaker on IT Governance, COBIT, Security and Compliance.
