

Implementing COBIT for IT Management and Governance

20th – 21st September at the City Inn Hotel, Birmingham



Organisations need to understand IT Governance and the Central UK Chapter is pleased to announce that it is offering the official ISACA COBIT course designed specifically for **Implementing COBIT for IT Management and Governance**. The course has been updated to reflect COBIT 4.1. This two-day workshop will concentrate on the much neglected implementation aspects of IT Governance and focus on the use of COBIT to achieve this. This course is specifically aimed at IT managers, IT auditors and consultants, preferably with some knowledge and experience of using COBIT.

The course leader is **Roger Southgate**, the London Chapter IT Governance Director and current Vice President. He is an experienced presenter and has delivered the workshop at EuroCACS 2007 in Vienna, The COBIT User Convention in Copenhagen and at the ISACA International Conference 2006 in Adelaide, South Australia. He is one of the few people in the world to be accredited by ISACA International to present this course.

COBIT® is an authoritative, up-to-date international set of generally accepted IT management best practices and control objectives written for business executives, IT professionals and IT auditors. It continues to develop as the leading guidance and set of resources for helping organisations to better manage IT, and provides a framework for implementing IT governance. In response to the need for guidance on how to implement COBIT to support governance initiatives and IT management practices, ISACA has developed this new workshop specifically aimed at IT managers and practitioners. The workshop will provide newly developed methods to help guide implementation activities and will include several case studies.

The course objectives will enable delegates to:

- Understand the principles and objectives of COBIT and the COBIT framework.
- Identify and know when to use the various components of COBIT.
- Understand the ITGI's approach to IT Governance and how COBIT supports this.
- Scope and plan IT Management/Governance initiatives based on COBIT.
- Assess IT Management Capability using the COBIT Maturity Models and Control Objectives.
- Plan control improvements using Control Objectives and Control Practices.
- Create a Performance Measurement framework using COBIT's Metrics and Scorecards.

The cost of the course is: £400.00 for all ISACA members or £550.00 for non-members.

The cost includes lunch and refreshments on both days and a full delegate pack. A maximum of 24 delegates can be accommodated, so in order to ensure your place please complete and return the registration form over the page **as soon as possible**.
